



McCulloch Farms- Whippoorwill Morgans is a world renowned horse breeding farm that, since 1945, has specialized in preserving the Original Morgan Horse. America's *first and most versatile* breed of horse.

Every spring, we open our doors and invite the public to meet our brand new foals. Two are expected before open barn. One may arrive just in time for the event. We may ask everyone to be very quiet, if foals are being born during the day.

On no set schedule, the “Barn Kids” (young and old) will show off the horses and demonstrate training and riding. We are here to welcome you and answer questions about Morgan Horses and about horses in general.

We are not a commercial boarding or riding stable, but a private family farm, established in 1928. This historic farm actually dates back to the revolutionary war. Visitors are welcome to walk the trails and around the beautiful lakes, 450 acres of Nature Conservancy protected land.

Please *do not* bring pets, nor “treats” to feed the horses.

Do wear sensible shoes, not flip-flops or sandals, as they are not safe near horse's feet. We want you to enjoy your visit. Cameras are fine. We are open rain or shine.

**I-95 Exit 70. Take Rt 1 North for 1.5 miles.
Turn right on Whippoorwill Road. Go 1.5 miles.
Blue sign on left. Long gravel driveway.
The way is clearly marked with blue and white signs.**
