Private consultations on September 23rd with SNAP staff in Old Lyme. No need to drive to Middletown or Norwich to apply. Appointments are preferred. Call 434-7208.

What to bring to your SNAP consultation on September 23rd:

- Photo ID
- Social Security numbers for everyone in your household
- Proof of where you live
- Proof of earned income for the last 4 months
- Proof of all other income (such as child support, or SSI)
- Proof of assets like bank accounts
- Proof of expenses:
 - Rent/Mortgage receipt
 - Utility bills (even if not in your name)
 - Childcare/Dependent costs
 - Child Support payments
- If you are 60 years or more, or disabled: Proof of medical expenses you pay out of your own pocket
