**THE TESTING OF THE LOCAL EMERGENCY ALERT SIREN SYSTEM
WILL BE CONDUCTED ON MONDAY JUNE 22, 2009**



On Monday June 22, 2009, technicians from the Millstone Power Station will be conducting siren testing on the recently installed emergency alert sirens throughout the Old Lyme community.

Testing will take place within the hours of 8:00 am through 6:00 pm. Both a siren activation tone test and a voice notification broadcast will be performed.

The sirens to be tested include the following locations.

1. Route 1, Boston Post Road, in the vicinity of Rogers Lake
2. Four Mile River Road
3. Jean Drive
4. Canty Lane
5. Shore Road, in the vicinity of the Black Hall River
6. Whipoorwill Road
7. Shore Road, in the vicinity of the I95 exit 70 off ramp.

Residents are advised to disregard the alerts, as this is only a test.
