HARBOR MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE
CHAPTER 58 OLD LYME CODE OF ORDINANCES

A. The following definitions shall be added to Article VII Terminology (§58-33):

Dock: A structure to which any form of watercraft may be secured. Such structure may be either floating, at any depth of water, or non-floating. Not to be construed as a float used for swimming.

Bulkhead: A structure built parallel, or nearly so, to the shore at the interface of the land and water.

Floating Dock: A platform designed to rise and fall with the tide which is connected to the shoreline or fixed dock, pier, wharf or walkway by a ramp.

Walkway: A narrow structure designed for non-vehicular use.

Wharf: Same as pier.

B. Article VIII (to be added)

§58-34. The standards for docks constructed in Old Lyme waters, approved by the State Department of Environmental Protection, State Department of Transportation and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and adopted by the Old Lyme Harbor Management Commission on July 14, 2009, shall be incorporated in the Harbor Management Ordinance.
