

Request for Proposals  
Hains Park Boathouse Project  
Old Lyme, CT

The Town of Old Lyme is soliciting proposals for the Hains Park Boathouse project which includes but is not limited to the installation and maintenance of temporary erosion and sedimentation controls, demolition of the existing Emerson Boathouse, demolition of an existing bituminous basketball court, construction of a new boathouse and associated site utilities, construction of a new basketball court and installation of miscellaneous site improvements.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting and site walk will take place at the Hains Park Emerson Boathouse, 166 Boston Post Road, Old Lyme, CT at 9am on 8 June 2016.
