

Request for Proposals

The Town of Old Lyme will receive sealed bids for work on the Village Estates subdivision in Old Lyme until 2pm local time on Wednesday, January 25, 2011 at the Old Lyme Town Hall, 52 Lyme St., Old Lyme, CT 06371, (or to selectmansoffice@oldlyme-ct.gov) at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Town may waive any informalities or other minor defects, or reject any or all bids if it is in the best interest of the town to do so.

Contractor shall perform the following work and provide materials in conformance with the "*Design and Construction Standards of the Town of Old Lyme*" and the "*Connecticut DOT Form 816*."

Work to be completed in the Village Estates Subdivision includes:

1. Guide Rail. 200+/- lf of 3-cable metal post guide rail (or approved equal) with end anchors. Note: as-constructed berm along road adjacent to drainage basins eliminates the need for the majority of guide rail in this area.
2. Picket Fence (vinyl 48" high) installation. 335+/- lf along n/f Moore property line adjacent to drainage basins.
3. Clear intersection sight lines along Route 156 (Neck Road) and clean catch basins along Village Lane (11 basins total).
4. Upper drainage basin: address water retention. Perform necessary work in the upper drainage basin which retains water after storm events. Work to include materials and labor to perform the following:
 - a. Excavate to 4+/- ft. depth and remove material from upper basin. Replace with washed ¾" - 1 ½" stone.
 - b. Place 2, 40+/- ft. long, 6" dia. perforated, fabric wrapped PVC pipe under drains in basin prior to placement of stone. Connect drains into existing outlet riser pipe.
 - c. Place 1, 3+/- ft. long, 6" dia. perforated PVC pipe drain @ basin surface. Connect drain into existing outlet riser pipe.
 - d. Provide necessary erosion control measures during construction.
 - e. Grade as necessary, seed and mulch disturbed areas.
5. Record plans for items 1 and 2 and sketch plan for item 4 are available for viewing in the Old Lyme Selectman's Office, Memorial Town Hall, 52 Lyme Street, Old Lyme, CT 06371.
