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### **8/5/13: UPDATE ON ROGERS LAKE DAM REPAIRS PROGRESS:**

The Town of Old Lyme has been making good progress on the completion of Dam Repairs at Rogers Lake. Here is a summary of progress up until now:

- Mattern Construction has been awarded the contract for the work
- Mattern Construction began preparations for work on 6/26/13
- Construction fence was installed along the East and West sides of project site
- Project sign has been installed and continues to be on display
- A turbidity curtain was installed in Rogers Lake up-gradient of the temporary by-pass pipe location
- Temporary by-pass pipe has been installed.
- A coffer dam (concrete barriers and sandbags) has been constructed around the work area of the dam
- Water is now flowing through by-pass pipe, with a weir controlling the water flow, while work is done to concrete around sluice gate.
- Concrete work on sluice has begun, w/spalled and deteriorated concrete facing removed, and forms for concrete have been installed

In addition to the work mentioned above, the Town of Old Lyme (TOL) representatives, Nathan L. Jacobson Associates (NLJA), and George Mattern Construction representatives have met bi-weekly to review work done, identify the work to be done over the coming two weeks, and to discuss any challenges that may arise.
