

Question:

RFP item 1.1 mentions review permit history and obtain copies of previous plans, surveys, and other pertinent reports and documents. Have any such documents been identified to date and if so what are they?

Three responses:

1. Searching for and reviewing historical records (with regard to dredging history, historical channel depths, data about users, etc.) has always been seen as an essential part of Phase I. I am not aware of existing relevant records. Finding what's there and what isn't is part of the job.
2. None to my knowledge; that is part of the study. Of course, we some records in town but the work involved to locate and assemble is part of the study, in my opinion.
3. I don't know answer ... I assumed that no studies have addressed the waterways in their entirety but some permits from DEEP and Corps of Engineers may have been obtained previously by the 2 or 3 private marinas. Also, the DEEP may have some information respecting their boat launching areas. I was thinking that this task would require the consultant to have the responsibility to investigate this matter with the DEEP, Corps of Engineers, Harbor Master and Harbor Mgmt Commission to see if any relevant studies, permits, etc. can be uncovered.
