

The Town of East Lyme, Connecticut, is seeking proposals from qualified firms to prepare a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) for Stones Ranch Military Reservation (SRMR), including Camp Niantic, and the surrounding communities.

The effort is funded by Department of Defense Office of Economic Adjustment (OEA) which provides grants to State and local governments to conduct a JLUS to support the long-term sustainability and operability of a military installation. Interested firms must demonstrate knowledge and experience in community planning, development and land use issues, fiscal impact analysis, economic development, and military installation management and operations.

A final JLUS will be completed by November 2015.
