

- Photo chemicals
- Full/partially-full aerosols
- Arts & crafts supplies
- Batteries: button or recyclable
- Mercury Thermometers
- Florescent light bulbs

Garage:

- Hand-held propane torch cylinders
- Old chemistry kits
- Transmission fluid
- Gasoline, kerosene
- Waxes and polishes
- Brake fluid
- Rust preventatives

Workshop:

- Wood preservatives
- Wood strippers
- Oil-based paint
- Lead-based paint
- Paint thinner
- Degreasers
- Solvents
- Sealants



Yard/Garden:

- Weed killer
- Insect sprays
- Rodent poison
- Muriatic acid/pool chemicals
- Cesspool cleaners

Unacceptable Materials

- Latex paint (*This can be air-dried or dried with sawdust or kitty litter and disposed in the garbage.*)
- Explosives, fireworks, ammunition (*Contact the State Police.*)
- BBQ Propane tanks
- Fire extinguishers
- Radioactive material
- Empty aerosol cans (*dispose in the garbage*)
- Drugs
- Infectious or biologically active materials
