

TOWN OF OLD LYME
TRANSFER STATION FEE SCHEDULE
(as of 23 June 2008)

The Old Lyme Transfer Station is located off Four Mile River Road, near Exit 71 of Route I-95. In order to receive a free landfill sticker, you must be an Old Lyme taxpayer (own property in Old Lyme or have your vehicle registered in Old Lyme). Stickers allow entrance to the Transfer Station site and can be obtained at the Selectman's Office. You must present your car registration to receive the sticker and stickers are only available for vehicles with a passenger registration or a pickup or van with a combination plate. The license plate number on the vehicle must match the license plate number on the sticker. **You must have vehicle registration and proof of property ownership with you in order to receive a sticker.** Call the Selectman's Office (860-434-1605, ext. 212) or the Transfer Station (860-434-2337) with any questions.

RECYCLING AREA

No additional fees for the following items (with Landfill Sticker):

- Clean glass and metal food containers (bottles and cans) * Waste Oil *
- Clean plastic containers (# 1& 2) * Motor vehicle batteries * Newspapers, magazines, office paper * Scrap metal * Corrugated cardboard (flattened) * Appliances that do not contain freon

Additional fees for the following items (with Landfill Sticker):

*Appliances that contain freon (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc)	\$10.00 per appliance
*Tires - Auto or Light Truck	\$2.00 per tire
- Heavy Truck/Race Car	\$10.00 per tire
- Construction Equipment	\$100.00 per tire
<i>-No Retail or Wholesale Tire Outlets-</i>	
*Soft goods - Box spring & mattress	\$15.00 per set
-Box spring or mattress	\$8.00 per item
-Large stuffed furniture	\$10.00 per item
- Small stuffed furniture	\$5.00 per item
- Carpet – over 8x10	\$10.00 per item
- 8x10 or less	\$5.00 per item
*Propane tanks – less than 20 pounds	\$1.00 per item
- 20 pounds (grill size)	\$3.00 per item
- Greater than 20 pounds	\$20.00 per item

Bulky Waste and Demolition Debris

Vehicles will be charged by weight @ 5.5 cents per pound or \$110 per ton.
Loads of less than 100 lbs. will be charged a minimum fee of \$5
Recyclables should not be mixed in the same load with bulky waste or demolition debris

Brush

Brush will be charged on a per load basis. No wood or limbs thicker than four inches will be accepted.

Grass

Grass clippings will not be accepted at the Transfer Station and cannot be deposited in your trash can. Please compost them on your property.

Curbside Recycling Collection:

- Set your items out by 7:30 AM
- Flatten all corrugated cardboard and tie into bundles (*note: pizza boxes are not recyclable*)
- Place all household papers in the covered recycling bin provided by the Town
- Crush milk jugs and other #1 and #2 plastic containers to reduce volume. Bag or place in a container that will protect against windy conditions
- Plastic items may be mixed with bottles and cans

Recycling saves the Town about \$50 per ton.

Cardboard (separate from other papers)

Bottles & Cans: (rinsed)

White, brown, green glass
Steel & aluminum cans
Aluminum foil
Aluminum pots & pans
Plastic bottles (#s 1 & 2)
Milk or juice drink bottles

Unacceptable

Plastic bags
Wax paper
Wax cardboard
Tissue paper
Plastic bottles (#s 3-7)
Plastic toys
Trash items
Pyrex ware
Food debris
Pizza boxes
Unrinsed containers
