POSITION(S) OPEN FULL TIME POLICE OFFICER(S)

The Town of Old Lyme is currently accepting applications for Full Time Police Officers to fill vacancies. The Old Lyme Police work under the direct supervision of the Connecticut State Police Resident Trooper program.

Applicants with P.O.S.T. certification are preferred, though all applicants will be considered. Current entry level pay for Police Officers is \$54,339.00.

The testing process may include, but is not limited to, a written exam, physical agility test, oral interview, thorough background investigation, polygraph, psychological, drug screening and physical exam.
