

Governor M. Jodi Rell today announced she is barring Executive Branch agencies from re-hiring state employees for more than two 120-day contracts. This will crack down on the practice known as “double-dipping,” where a retired employee returns to work for the state for many additional years while drawing a pension. Though Governor Rell has no direct administrative authority over the University of Connecticut, the UConn Health Center, the Connecticut State University system or the community-technical college system, she is asking the trustees of each to impose the same policy.
