I also wanted to let you all know that The Connecticut Department of Transportation has announced that roadside safety improvements will be performed on **Route 1 in Old Saybrook, Westbrook and Clinton beginning Monday, September 14, and will continue through Friday, October 16.**

LANE CLOSURE INFO

Motorists can expect alternating lane closures to occur on Route 1 from the I-95 overlap in Old Saybrook to the Clinton/Madison Town Line.

Traffic control personnel and signing patterns will be utilized to guide motorists through the work zone. The regular work schedule for this project is from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (Monday-Friday).

Motorists should be aware that modifications or extensions to this schedule may become necessary due to weather delays or other unforeseen conditions. Motorists are advised to maintain a safe speed when driving in this vicinity.
