MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF May 10, 2023

A meeting of the Rogers Lake Authority (RLA) was convened at Rogers Lake Clubhouse at 7:30 PM on May 10, 2023. The meeting was called to order at 7:30pm by Dennis Overfield. The following members were present: Toni Phillips, Maneesha Joshi, and Dick Smith. There was also 1 local attendee. The minutes were recorded by Erica Correia.

The April 12<sup>th</sup> minutes were read aloud and a motion to accept the minutes was made by Toni Phillips and seconded by Maneesha Joshi. Motion passed unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**March & April 2023, budget review**

- March expenditure were Clerk, John Freer, and Clam services
- Only expenditure in April was boat battery jumper
- Overall in good financial shape

**Patrol Boat**

### **Meeting with DEEP**

- Map sign for boat launch – total cost (3ftx3ft on aluminum) = \$155.79
- Launch ramp presence – Mark will work to get letter that states we can be there.
- Unauthorized manipulation of Rogers Lake water level – Call with DEEP representative Matthew Goclowksi (Supervising Fisheries Biologist) and others to discuss the manipulation of the lake levels with the dam. DEEP says it is a violation of state statute to open the sluice gate for flood control. DEEP is concerned with the alewives going over the dam and dying so RLA is trying to work with state to determine how we can not flood properties and also not hurt the alewives. DEEP will get back to us within a month. Matthew Goclowksi said when dam was rebuilt in 2013 the town of Old Lyme had to file a new emergency operation procedure as part of the rebuild and this was not completed. Dennis will notify Tim Griswold that Matthew Goclowksi stated the town needs to comply with this.

Toni Phillips made a motion that if sign for boat launch costs under \$500 that Dennis Overfield go ahead and order the sign. Maneesha Joshi seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
