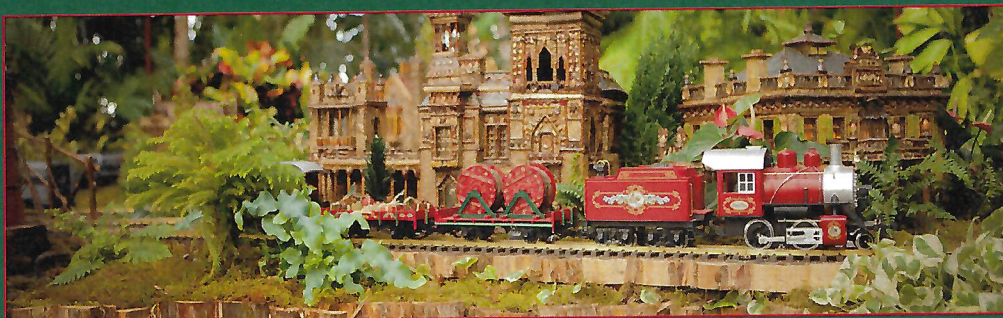
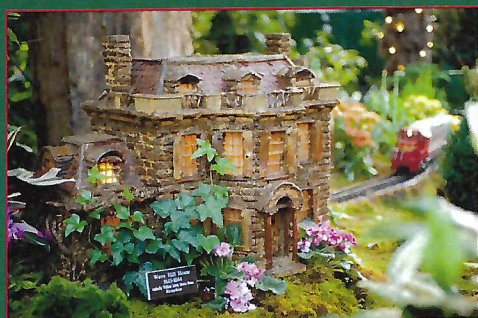


New York Botanical Garden Holiday Train Show
