# Overview of River Valley Transit


- Public Transit Provider for Middlesex County
- New name for the recently combined Middletown Area Transit and 9-Town Transit systems
- One new system and brand for all of Middlesex County and more



# Our Current Services

- We operate 13 fixed bus routes
- Destinations include cities and towns in Middlesex County, New London, Meriden
- Transfer with services that provide access to New Haven and Hartford
- Dial-a-Ride Service
- ADA Paratransit Service
- XtraMile On-Demand Service

# Route 643 Old Saybrook/ New London

- Service in Old Saybrook, Old Lyme, East Lyme, and New London
- Predominantly in Old Lyme
- Regional transit connections available in Old Saybrook and New London (bus, rail, ferry)

# Dial-Ride

- Dial-a-Ride fills the gaps in service not covered by bus routes
- Dial-a-Ride is a reservation-based curb-to-curb service
- Any trip that originates or ends more than  $\frac{3}{4}$  a mile away from a fixed route is eligible for Dial-a-Ride service
- No application required
- Not just a medical service, can be used for any reason
- Wheelchair Accessible



# Dial-a-Ride Continued



- Hours of service are from 7am-5pm Monday-Friday
- Reservations can be made up to two weeks in advance and must be made no later than 4pm the day prior to your desired ride
- First come first served basis, and will sometimes fill up
- Subscription service is available for consistent usage for medical, employment or education trips

# Taxi Voucher Program

- Grant funding to help reduce the cost of travel outside of our service area
- We pay for 50% of your taxi ride
- The service is available for seniors over 60 or persons with disabilities
- Riders submit a taxi voucher application form
- Taxi will take riders anywhere in Connecticut



# Bus Stop Project

- Bus routes currently operate with a **flag stop system**
  - Riders waive the driver down anywhere along the route
  - This leads to safety and operational issues
- We are undergoing a **bus stop transition**
  - Improved safety through safe locations for stops
  - Improved operational efficiency through stop grouping / improved clarity
  - Increased awareness of availability of transit service


# Old Lyme Proposed Bus Stops

- 22 stops on municipal roads
  - Looking for town approval
- 36 stops on state roads
  - Working with CTDOT for approval
- Open to feedback on any of the stops
