

TOWN OF OLD LYME
ANNUAL BUDGET MEETING

Approximately 35 electors and citizens attended the Annual Budget Meeting on Tuesday, May 26, 2009, at 7:30 PM in the Meeting Hall of the Old Lyme Memorial Town Hall, 52 Lyme Street, Old Lyme, Connecticut.

First Selectman Timothy C. Griswold called the meeting to order.

Eileen C. Clarke was elected to serve as Moderator.

Assistant Town Clerk Eileen K. Coffee read the call of the meeting.

1. A motion was made and seconded to adopt the Budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, for \$31,046,444 as recommended by the Board of Finance.
Motion carried
2. A motion was made and seconded to adopt a proposal that taxes in the Town of Old Lyme on Real Estate and Personal Property shall be paid in two (2) semi-annual installments, the first payment being due on July 1, 2009 and the second payment on January 1, 2010. Any tax in these categories under \$100.00 will be due in full in one payment in July, 2009, as are vehicles on Supplemental List due in January, 2010 in one payment.

Motion carried

3. A motion was made and seconded to adopt an ordinance restricting the operation of motorbuses and bus-type campers on Bocce Lane, Hartford Avenue, Martino Avenue, Portland Avenue and Swan Avenue, as recommended by the Board of Selectmen. A motion was made and seconded to amend the above ordinance as follows: An exception may be granted at the discretion of the First Selectman for other special circumstances through a written request to the Selectman's Office with thirty (30) days advanced notice.

Motions carried

4. A motion was made and seconded to adopt amendments to the Flood and Erosion Control Board ordinance staggering terms of the five regular members and creating three alternate member positions.

Motion carried
