



TOWN OF OLD LYME TRANSFER STATION

HOURS Tuesday - Friday: 7:30 AM - 3:45 PM;
Saturday: 8:30 AM - 4PM
Closed Sunday & Monday

The Transfer Station is located on Four Mile River Road, near Exit 71, Route I-95. Free windshield stickers are available to Old Lyme taxpayers only (you must own property or register your vehicle in Old Lyme). Stickers allow entrance to the Transfer Station Recycling Area and can be obtained at the Selectman's Office in the Town Hall. You must present your vehicle registration and proof of Old Lyme property ownership to receive the sticker. The license plate number of the vehicle must match the license plate number on the sticker.

The items listed on this sheet CANNOT be deposited in your BLUE trash bins

RECYCLING AREA

No fees for the following items (with windshield sticker):

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING ITEMS (see list on next page)

Waste Oil; Motor vehicle batteries; Small appliances (no freon)

Covered and non-covered electronic devices (CEDs) including computers (personal computers, mainframes, midrange computers, laptops); networking equipment (hubs, switches, control cards, etc.); computer monitors; televisions, printers; keyboards; mice; adaptors; stereos; speakers; VCRs; scanners, fax machines; copiers; telephones and telephone systems; computer wire and cable; computer drives and storage devices (floppy drives, CD ROMs, harddrives); power supplies; circuit boards; microwaves; scrap copper (cable, pipe, etc.), scrap aluminum; (machine and machine parts, cable extrusions, etc.); fluorescent light bulbs; UPS (uninterrupted power supply) batteries and related computer and electronic equipment; box springs and mattresses

FEE SCHEDULE

Bulky Waste and Demolition Debris:

Vehicles will be charged by weight @ 8 cents per pound or \$160 per ton.

Loads of less than 100 lbs. will be charged a minimum fee of \$8.00

Recyclables should not be mixed in the same load with bulky waste or demolition debris

Fees for the following items:

Tires: *Auto no rim \$6/tire * Auto w/rim \$7/tire * Light Truck \$10/tire

Construction Equipment \$115 per tire * **No Retail or Wholesale Tire Outlets**

Upholstered furniture: *Large \$10 per item * Small \$5 per item

Carpet: *Over 8x10 \$10 per item * 8x10 or less \$5 per item

Propane tanks: <20 pounds \$1 each * 20 pounds (grill size) \$3 each >20 pounds \$20 each

Brush & Grass:

Brush will be charged on a per load basis at \$60 per ton.

Grass clippings are not accepted at the Transfer Station.

No wood or limbs longer than 6 feet will be accepted.

Brush & grass cannot be deposited in your BLUE trash or GREEN recycling bins.

Please compost them on your property.

Leaves:

Leaves cannot be deposited in your BLUE trash or GREEN recycling bins.

Please compost them on your property.

Old Lyme Taxpayers may dispose of leaves from their properties at no charge.

Residents must empty and remove paper or plastic bags.

Contractors who collect leaves from Old Lyme properties will be charged as follows:

Pickup truck or small trailer charge is \$40

Larger vehicles/trailers-Charge determined by town personnel

Contractors must empty and remove paper or plastic bags.

Town personnel have final word on unique situations.

Curbside Single Stream Recycling Pick-up

Set your Green Recycling bin out by 6 AM.

ALL RECYCLABLES MUST BE CLEAN, EMPTY & LOOSE IN THE GREEN BIN
NO PLASTIC BAGS IN GREEN RECYCLING BIN
DO NOT SEPARATE RECYCLABLE PLASTIC, GLASS, METAL, AND PAPER

YES, these items can be recycled in curbside bin:

All rigid plastic #1 to #7 (not black, other colors OK); Plastic milk & juice jugs
Plastic soda & detergent bottles; Plastic buckets & crates; Plastic flower pots (not black, other colors OK)
Glass (clear, white, green, & brown); Aluminum cans & foil; Juice & milk cartons
Books (Hardcover & paperback); Cardboard (flattened) Catalogs; Colored paper; Envelopes (window okay)
File folders; school/office papers; Junk mail; Magazines & brochures; Newspapers & inserts; Paper bags
Pizza Box (no greasy liners) Boxes (cereal, egg cartons)

NO, these items can not be recycled in curbside bin:

Plastic bags or plastic film; bagged recyclables; Black plastic (other colors OK); Food or take-out containers that are not clean and empty; Electronics; Light and Fluorescent bulbs; Pizza boxes (greasy); Pyrex glassware; Drinking glasses; Ceramic plates and mugs; Pots & Pans; Plastic and wire clothes hangers; Shipping peanuts; Styrofoam; Shredded Paper; Yard Waste; Hazardous waste; Batteries; Motor oil containers; Paint cans; Needles or syringes

Household Hazardous Waste

Hauler and Residential Bin Information

The Town of Old Lyme contracts with CWPM (860-447-1473) for curbside collection of household trash and single stream recycling. A **BLUE** bin is provided for collection of household trash only -- no yard waste, recycling, or hazardous waste of any kind may be placed in the blue container. A **GREEN** bin is provided for collection of single stream recycling only (not in plastic bags). Both containers are the property of the Town of Old Lyme and are assigned to a specific address.
